Password protection also ensures that a single individual's opinions are counted only once.

If you would like to participate by mail, please complete the questionnaire by the traditional pen-and-paper method, place the questionnaire in the postage-paid envelope provided, and drop it in the mail as soon as it is convenient.

If it is at all possible for you to do so, we would appreciate your completing the survey by June 16. Your timely completion will enable our survey firm to compile the results and quickly put this valuable information in the hands of the board for decision-making and planning.
